

ACRYLIC PAINTING 101: Basics for Beginners

~ Exercise 11

Focus: Colour Mixing – GREEN



We have so many different types of green that we could choose to mix but for this lesson I have chosen to start off with a simple but powerful combination of Cadmium Yellow Light and Bone (Ivory) Black. Bone Black is a low chroma Blue, which is why it can be a challenge when one decides to use a Black to darken the value when painting.
